Sealed Bids for the Cameron County Commissioners' proposed Driftwood Borough Water Service Meter Installation – Phase II project will be received by the Commissioners at the Driftwood Senior Center. Bids shall be mailed to **Driftwood Borough**, **7806 Bridge Street**, **Suite 101, Driftwood, PA 15832** or hand delivered to the Senior Center at **7806 Bridge Street, Suite 101, Driftwood, PA 15832** until **10:30am** on **Thursday March 20, 2025** at which time the bids received will be publicly opened and read at the Cameron County Commissioners' meeting shortly after 11:00am. The project involves the procurement and installation of 19 individual water service meter pits and new curb stops/boxes, along with all appurtenances and restoration.

The Issuing Office for the Bidding Documents is Keller Engineers, Inc., 420 Allegheny Street, Hollidaysburg, PA 16648. Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 8:00am and 5:00pm and must obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below.

Bidding Documents are available digitally by contacting the above Issuing Office. Printed copies of the Bidding Documents may also be obtained, during the hours indicated above, upon payment of a deposit of \$75.00. Bidders who return full sets of the Bidding Documents in good condition (suitable for re-use) within 10 days after receipt of Bids will receive a full refund. Checks for Bidding Documents shall be payable to "Keller Engineers, Inc.". Upon request and receipt of the document deposit indicated above plus a non-refundable shipping charge, the Issuing Office will transmit the Bidding Documents via delivery service. The date that the Bidding Documents are transmitted by the Issuing Office will be considered the Bidder's date of receipt of the Bidding Documents. Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

A bid bond or certified check payable to the County of Cameron in the amount of 10% of the bid price will be required. This project will be funded by a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG). As such, Davis-Bacon Federal Wage Rates, Equal Employment Opportunity, Copeland Anti-Kickback Act, along with additional Federal requirements, will apply to all work. Minority and Women Owned Businesses and Certified Section 3 Businesses are encouraged to submit a proposal. Bidders must submit documentary evidence of minority and women business enterprises which have been contacted and to which commitments have been made. Documentation of solicitations and commitments shall be submitted concurrently with the bid.

The owner reserves the right, as its interest may require, to reject any and all proposals or to waive any formalities or technicalities. Bids may be held by the owner for no more than 60 days from the date of opening bids for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the qualifications of bidders prior to awarding the contract.
